Club Vehicle registration for Chevrolet Club of NSW (CCNSW)

To obtain Club registration you must be a current member of the Chevrolet Club of NSW for the year of vehicle registration. You may be required to show your current club membership and carry the club magazine with you if on a club trip.

Historic Vehicle registration and 60 day logbook system, H plates NON MODIFIED vehicles.

You must present your vehicle to the club registrar for inspection to ensure it meets the vehicle standard as specified by the manufacturer The vehicle must meet all NSW Registration requirements. This inspection is to be arranged with the Club Registrar at a mutually agreed time. You will obtain a form 1259 (Historic Vehicle Declaration) and form 1021 (Change of Records if going onto the 60 day scheme) from Motor Vehicle Registration offices, or download from the internet. Complete Form 1259, sections 1, 2, 3 and bring with you to the inspection, the club registrar will then sign the form put the official CCNSW stamp on your form to take to the Registration office.

The 60 Day logbook scheme, you must enter into the logbook details of your trip before departing your home. You must have the completed logbook with you and present to an officer when asked. Trip must be in the logbook prior to leaving.

Modified Registration 60 day logbook scheme for Modified vehicles D Plates

Your vehicle must meet all Engineering requirements and Blue slip inspection of the Motor Registration Office nominated Blue Slip inspection station.

You will need 3 forms (Form 1021 Change of Records), Form 1246 Application for conditional Registration) and Form 1835 (Classic Vehicle Declaration) to complete. Complete Form 1835, sections, 1 and 2, when completed, will be stamped with CCNSW by our Club Registrar, then forward your form to APMC (the nominated authority (Fee applies)) for their official stamp.

All completed and stamped forms to be taken to Motor Registration office

The 60 Day logbook scheme, you must enter into the logbook details of your trip before departing your home. You must have the completed logbook with you and present to an officer when asked. If you wish to drive down to fill the car with petrol, then back home, it must be in the logbook prior to leaving
